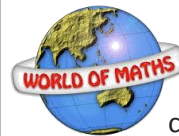

EASTER FUN

- ▼ **BUNNY HOPPING RELAYS**
Ensure children transfer their weight onto their arms, developing upper body strength. A jumping sack race is another fun idea, use a fabric reusable supermarket bag
- ▼ **ROB THE NEST**
Place balls in a hoop or basket and encourage the children to run and take from another's nest, to fill their own nest
- ▼ **EGG AND SPOON RACES**
Use a spoon and a hard boiled egg, small potato or water balloon
- ▼ **EASTER EGG/ CARROT ROLLS**
Do forward rolls if the children are able to safely or encourage them to be the longest carrot they can be, and roll
- ▼ **CHICKEN DANCE**
Teach the children the actions, have a great time wiggling
- ▼ **EASTER HUNT**
Make a treasure hunt with clues for the children to follow and at each stop they find the next clue. At the end of the hunt the children enjoy an Easter treat such as a hot cross bun or a bunny snack platter
