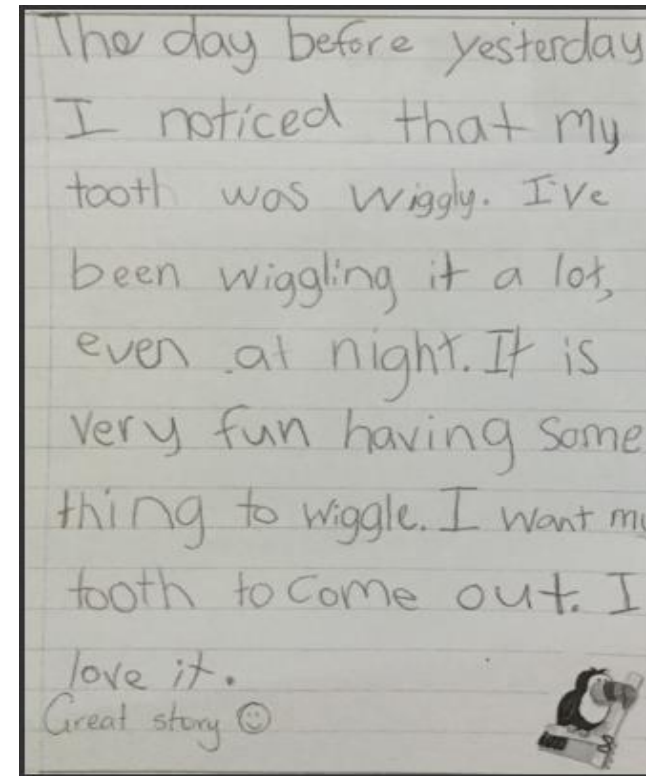

## First Aid Tips

If you get a cut or abrasion to the skin, follow these simple first aid tips:

1. Wash hands with soapy water for 20 seconds and dry for 20 seconds before cleaning the wound.
2. Clean the wound with running tap water and a clean cloth.
3. Dry with a clean cloth, then put cloth in the rubbish once you have finished.
4. Cover the wound with a fabric plaster (change plaster daily).
5. Cut nails as germs live under long fingernails. It also helps lower the chance of scratches.
