Autumn Lunches

When the weather begins to cool down children start to get hungrier and thinking of what to put in your child's lunchbox can be difficult. So here are a few ideas for healthy and filling lunch items.

Sandwiches are always a good start and an extra one put in for morning tea will help fill your child up and give them some energy for learning.

Filling ideas:- Marmite-cheese-cold meat- hummus-lettuce-cucumber-grated carrot-beansprouts-honey-jam. If sandwiches are not popular try wraps for a change or rolls.
