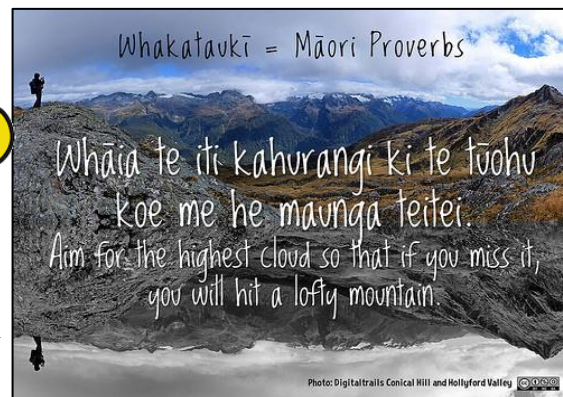

How prepared are we for a disaster?

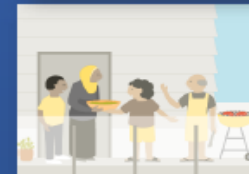
