ALERT LEVEL 2

- It is really important children do return to school, not just for their education but also their health and wellbeing.
- Instances of Covid-19 in New Zealand are very low and here in Wellington Region we have 0 cases, with the last case reported on 16 April.
- We are aware of concerns out there that people without symptoms may be able to spread the virus. The Ministry of Health has advised us that there is no instance in New Zealand of someone spreading the virus without ever having symptoms
- The Ministry of Education say our schools are safe. Even though there is such a low risk of the virus getting in the school gates to start with, we will be keeping up our safe hygiene practices and other public health measures as an extra precaution for as long as we're at Alert Level 2.
- If your child is unwell, you must keep them at home but all other students must now return to school as **we are no longer offering Distance Learning.**
- We continue to need contact tracing details and ask anyone entering the school to sign in. **Please do not come into school unless it is necessary to do so.**
- Thank you all for helping us manage students' entry and exit to school safely and sensibly.

There will be a teacher only day on Friday 3rd July at MPS. This is so all teachers can attend a first aid course. This course was supposed to take place on April the 9th last term but was postponed because of Covid 19.
