**Who can go to school**

All children can attend school at this level. Schools  
must be open.

**Who should not go to school**

If people are sick, they should stay home (phone  
Healthline or their GP and get tested if a doctor or

Anyone who is self-isolating, or who has been  
advised by health authorities to remain at home  
while they wait for their COVID-19 test results must  
stay home.

This packet has 16 pieces of rubbish.

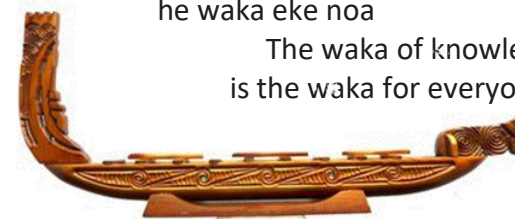

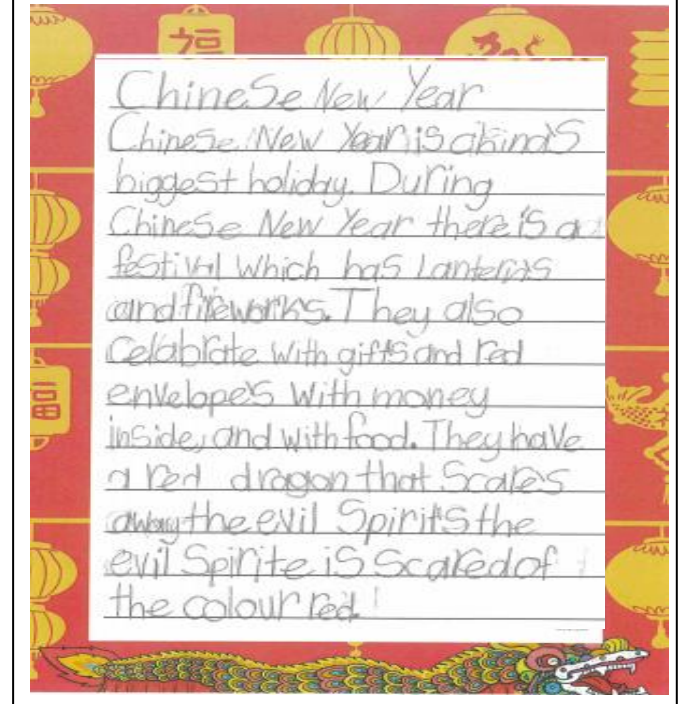
