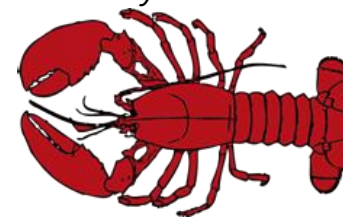
Please make sure you have paid your camp fees and returned all the necessary forms.
