The Prime Minister Jacinda Ardern announced last night that NZ is moving to Alert Level 2 from 12 midday on the 12th August. Auckland will be moving to Alert level 3. Parents and caregivers will need to know what Alert level 2 will look at MPS from midday today.

- Students will only be able to be on site between 8.15am- 2.40pm
- Most parents/caregivers will not be able to be on the school site before or after school. Those adults that do come into school will have to sign in at the office giving their name, time and contact details.
- All "visiting" adults must ensure they maintain the 2 metre physical distancing from all people at all times.
- From this afternoon students will be brought to the front gate by classroom teachers to be picked up in the walkway area by their parents/caregivers. Students in rooms 1, 2, 4 and 6 will be brought out first starting at 2.20.
- Students arriving on site who display any signs of sickness, mild or severe, should not be attending school and will be sent home. (This includes runny noses, coughs, respiratory problems and common cold symptoms).
- Drinking fountains are still not available to use and students will still need to bring their own water bottles.
- There will be no Friday assembly this week.
- Breakfast club will not operate on this Thursday and Friday.
