Good morning

We are planning for what will happen at MPS when we move to Alert Level 3.

Parents and caregivers need to know what this involves for our students.

- Parents / Caregivers do not have to send their children to school – they will continue to have distance education throughout Level 3.
- If all of the adults at home are required to be at a physical workplace and cannot work from home and no other care can be provided during this time we are able to cater for a small number of students on site at MPS.
- Students will only be able to be on site between 8.40am and 2.30pm
- If the rules are the same as last year, at Alert Level 3 we are only able to have very small class “bubbles” of 10 people including staff.
- Parents / Caregivers will not be able to be on the school site before or after school.
- Not all staff are able to be present at school.
