Newsletter Advertising

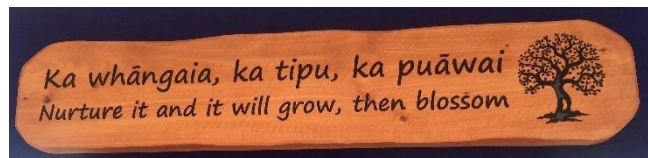
We are looking for support
