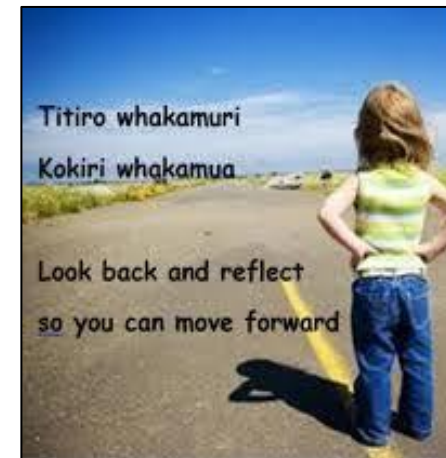
## PROVIDING THE AHHA! MOMENTS

| Newborns : 0-3 months                  | 14 to 17   |
| Infants: 4-11 months                   | 12 to 15   |
| Toddlers: 1-2 years                    | 11 to 14   |
| Pre-schoolers: 3-5 years               | 10 to 13   |
| School-aged children: 6-13 years       | 9 to 11  |
| Teenagers: 14-17 years                 | 8 to 10  |
| Young adults/adults: 18-25/26-64 years | 7 to 9   |
| Older adults: ≥65 years                | 7 to 8   |
