MR FOUREYES/FOUREYES FOUNDATION

Dear whanāu,
Over the past 2 years we have been running eye screening service for families and children under the age of 18. We have also provided free eye exams for children as part of this service through Whaioira medical centre.

We have helped support 16 schools, and over 3000 kids in Wairarapa – this is one person and a small number of volunteers. We will continue to help children in the area and provide these services for free through our charity (Foureyes Foundation).

How can you help us?

Recently we have started providing eye exams for adults, and providing glasses or replacement lenses:

- 100% of eye exam fees go back to the charity.
- Glasses – every purchase funds our charity, which provides the free services to children.
- Lenses – we offer one of the most affordable options to keep your frames and swap the lenses. This also helps the charity.

In a nutshell – every purchase as an adult directly supports a charity helping your kids in the community for the past 3 years.

How can we help you?

We will continue our work with schools and provide the screening for free, but if you want to book your child in for an eye exam – just call us at Whaioira. As mentioned, it is free (and will continue to be free for kids).
