



REPORTING TO PARENTS/WHANAU AT MASTERTON PRIMARY SCHOOL

All students at Masterton Primary School will have a report on their year's 'Progress and Achievement' in a term close to their birthdate and an 'Interim Report' two terms later, which is two reports each year. In the terms that these reports are due you will receive a notice to say that you and your child are due to have a '3 Way Learning Conference' with their teacher. This is when you and your child are invited to come in and see the work they have done over their two terms and discuss their progress. A written report will go home after this meeting. We strongly encourage you to take the opportunity to support your child and celebrate their successes by attending their 3 Way Learning Conferences. It is also a time to plan for their next steps in learning and to talk about ways you can help them make progress. You may notice a reminder about 3 Way Learning Conferences in the newsletter each term but please remember that your child will only be due two in any one year. You will only be due a report on your child if they have had a birthday recently or it is two terms since their last report. A notice will be sent home with your child when they are due for a report.
