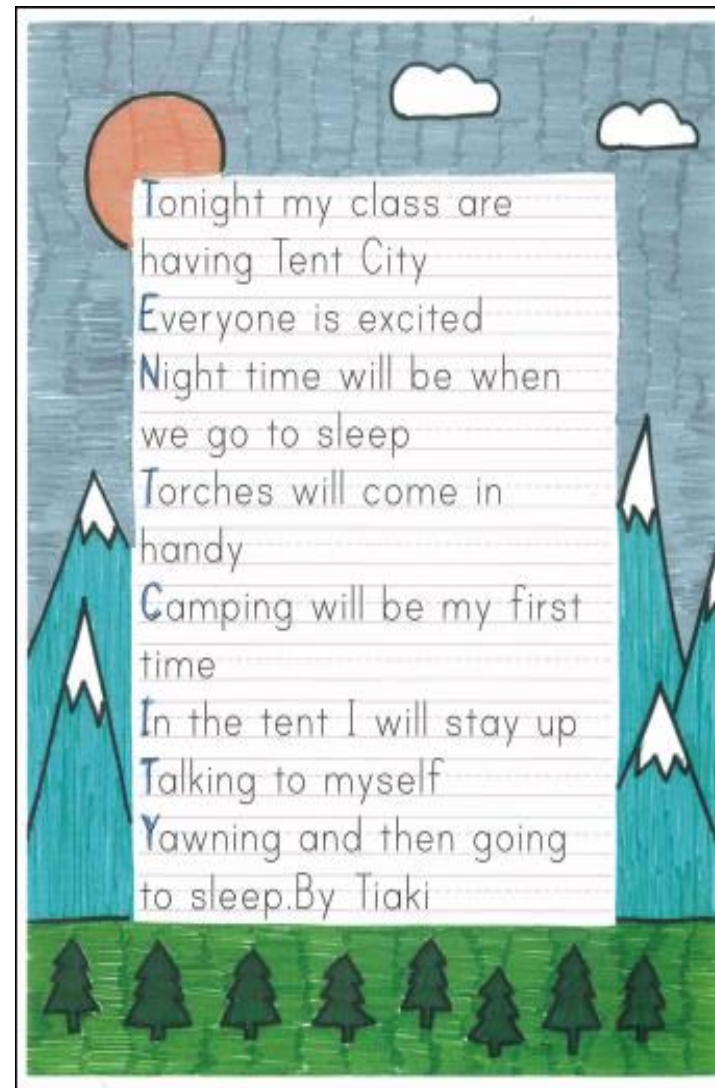

 We encourage students to walk, cycle or scooter to school.

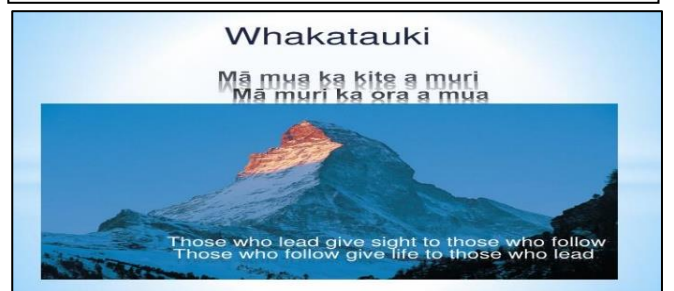
When? Monday 16th March – Friday 20th March
