- Hearing and Vision for 5 and 6 year old children who did not complete their B4 School Checks
- Other children who have not yet completed routine vision and hearing screening

**This screening is not a full assessment**

*Near vision used for reading books or hand writing is unable to be screened by this service*

*If you have concerns in regards to your child's vision please arrange an appointment with an Optometrist*

You will be contacted if further assessment is recommended for your child. Children who wear glasses and/or are under professional care for vision or hearing and have regular checks will not require screening by our service.

**If you do NOT consent to your child being screened please contact the school to advise them.**
