Alert Level 2 information from Ministry of Education

Who can go to school

All children can attend school at this level. Schools must be open.

Who should not go to school

If people are sick, they should stay home (phone Healthline or their GP and get tested if a doctor or health professional recommends to do so). Anyone who is self-isolating, or who has been advised by health authorities to remain at home while they wait for their COVID-19 test results must stay home.

Health requirements at school

At Alert Level 2 the disease is contained. It is safe for children and staff to attend schools, early learning services and tertiary education. There will be appropriate measures in place. We look forward to seeing all children at school at Alert Level 2 unless they are unwell.

Just letting our MPS families know that a bill has been passed in Parliament banning smoking in cars which carry children under 18 years of age.

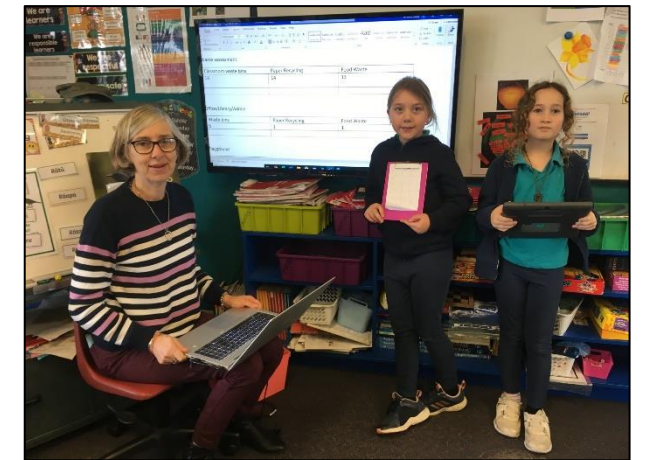
Lucky Book Club
