Masterton Primary School Lunch Scheme

MPS is pleased to announce that The Ministry of Education will be providing a school lunch for every child attending Masterton Primary School on every school day from Monday 10th May, which is the second week of Term 2. All children will be provided with a Free Healthy School Lunch, delivered to their classrooms at lunchtime. Children will still need to bring their healthy morning tea each day and the Fruit in Schools will continue. Before the start of the school lunch roll out we need to identify any known special dietary requirements of our students. We need to give this information to the school lunch providers as soon as possible so they can set up their kitchens to cater for all of our students. To help us with this we will be sending home a form with your child and every child needs a form returned to school with the information requested. If you have more than one child please fill in a form for each child. Even if your child has no special dietary requirements please return the form with that information ticked. Please note that only ethical, religious or medical dietary requirements are noted. *It does not extend to food preferences, fussy eating, or non-medical aversions to particular foods.*
