Alert levels

All of New Zealand (except Auckland) will move to **alert level 2** from **11.59pm Tuesday, September 7**. Auckland will remain in **level 4** until at least **Tuesday, September 14**.

Alert level 4: Auckland

- Stay at home in your bubble
- Wear a mask and maintain social distancing of 2m if you do go outside
- You can leave your home to:
 - Shop for essential goods
 - Exercise in your neighbourhood
 - Receive necessary medical care
 - Get a Covid test

Alert level 2: Rest of NZ

- Get a Covid test if you experience cold or flu symptoms
- Face coverings mandatory inside indoor venues, public transport and flights
- Indoor venues limited to 50 people
- Outdoor venues limited to 100 people
- Maintain social distancing of 2m in gyms, museums and libraries

Mandatory record-keeping comes into effect from 11.59pm Tuesday, September 7
