## SCHOOL CROSSING

*After recent observations outside MPS, we have seen many parents not using the crossing to walk their children to the school gate and again when picking them up. I do ask that parents are mindful that this is setting up congestion near the school gate and minimising the chances of some students being seen when crossing the road.*

*I want to thank the students that volunteer their time to arrive early and leave late to man the road patrol crossing so that we can have a space to cross safely. I ask all parents and whanau that do the school runs, to please be mindful of others. Park and walk your children to the zebra crossing instead of crossing amongst the traffic. I also ask that when parking your vehicle, you are not blocking someone's driveway or parking over yellow lines. This reduces visibility and is plainly not considerate towards your fellow school community. We are working with police and infringements will be given out if a demonstration of behaviour change is not taken - after all, our tamariki watch and follow what we do. Please set a positive example. If you do see something happening that shouldn't be outside the school gate during pick up and drop off times, please inform the school office."*
